

Extension Program Grants

The Macon County 4-H and Extension Foundation is offering yearly grants to support Extension programs in 4-H Youth Development, Horticulture and Master Gardeners, Agriculture and Family and Consumer Economics. Requests for funds must reflect the spirit of the mission of 4-H or University of Illinois Extension.

Proposal Guidelines

Proposal should include a cover sheet, 2 pages of explanation and a 1 page budget.

Cover sheet should include:

- Project Title
- Club or Group Submitting the Proposal
- Extension Area (4-H, Master Gardeners, etc.)
- Contact Name, Address, E-mail and Phone Number
- Number of persons reached with the project
- Amount of Request

Proposal should include no more than 2 pages to explain your project, including:

- Goals for the project
- Timeline and steps to complete the project
- Expected impact on both individuals and the group
- Plans to contact the media about the project and the grant funds
- Evaluation: How do you know your project is a success?

Budget should include all expenditures for the project, including other sources of funding in addition to this grant proposal.

Proposals should be submitted to University of Illinois Extension, Macon County Office and will be reviewed bimonthly by the Foundation Scholarship Committee.
